First and foremost, we hope that this letter finds you and your family in good health and that you are having a great start to the 2022-2023 academic school year.

We wanted to inform you that the New York City School Construction Authority (SCA) has notified us of necessary construction and repairs that need to be conducted to our school building. Due to the construction, scaffolding will be built around our school building which will impact the space and use of our school yard.

The limited space will have a direct effect on our ingress (student arrival to school) and egress (student dismissal). We anticipate that our ingress procedures and protocol will remain the same, students will line up by class in the remaining accessible portion of the school yard and be greeted by their teacher at 8:00 am and escorted to their classroom. Due to the limited space and access of the school yard, during egress (dismissal), we will no longer be able to accommodate the capacity of families in the school yard. For this reason, families will stand outside of the school yard gates on 30th street while teachers dismiss their classes.

While this work will cause some challenges, we are excited for the changes that will be made to enhance and upgrade our school building. The projected timeline for our project is one year, beginning on October 11, 2022. We hope that this project stays the course and completion is finalized in a timely manner. As always, we appreciate your patience and understanding as we work together with the SCA to enhance the learning environment for our students and the longevity of our school building.
