As you know, in person (blended learning) has resumed across all NYC School Districts. The blended model means that students will have some school days in person and some school days remotely. In order to support families, the Department of Education has created the Learning Bridges Program. Please be aware that students **MUST** be enrolled in blended learning/hybrid schedules (100% remote students are not eligible) to be able to attend a Learning Bridges program.
