ELA:

After closely analyzing the data, we determined that the skill of making inferences is an area that needs our focus. Strengthening students' skills in making inferences will improve their comprehension in both informational and literary texts by helping them identify meanings of unknown words, identifying the central message, and identifying the theme, which were all areas in need of improvement.

Action Plan:

MATH:
