In doing so, Congress recognizes the continuing importance of math and science education programs; and encourage schools and educators to observe the day with appropriate activities that teach students about Pi and engage them about the study of mathematics.

The purpose of the day is to foster creativity in and enjoyment of mathematics. Each class will be engaged in Pi Day Station Activities to encourage students to participate in mathematics in imaginative and alternative ways.
