Remote Learning Grading Policy

What do the numbers mean?

We will continue to use a 4-point scale to determine level of mastery.

Rubric Level	Description	Assessments graded on a percentage basis correlation
4	Exceeds Grade Standards	*95% and above
3	Meets Grade Standards	75%-94%
2	Below Grade Standards	65%-74%
1	Well Below Grade Standards	64% and below

What percentage of each area totals my child’s overall grades?

Each of the below categories are weighted within each of the subject areas taught throughout the school year, which consist of, but are not limited to, Reading, Math, Science, Social Studies and The Arts .

Quizzes	20%
Participation/Engagement	50%
Classwork	30%
