School Uniforms

Dear Parents/Guardians:

In consultation with our PTA and SLT our school has voted to become a uniform school. Our school colors are Red & Black.

According to the Chancellor's Regulation: "The voluntary uniform policy is intended to help schools promote a more effective learning climate; foster school unity and pride; improve student performance; foster self-esteem; eliminate label competition; simplify dressing and minimize costs to parents; teach children appropriate dress and decorum in their "work" place; and help to improve student conduct and discipline."

Students should come to school wearing the school uniform as stated below:

1. Red long or short sleeve polo style shirt for girls and boys respectively
2. Black pants for boys and girls or black skirt or jumper for girls
3. Red sweater or sweatshirt

For Gym days:

1. Red T-shirt
2. Black shorts or pants for boys or girls
3. Sneakers

For Assemblies/Performances the Uniform is as follows:

1. White shirt or blouse (long or short sleeve) for boys and girls respectively
2. Black pants for boys and girls, or black skirt or jumper for girls
3. Red tie/bow

Parents can purchase these items anywhere. Please note that you can also order gym uniforms and red polo style shirts and sweatshirts with the school logo at the school. If you are interested please, visit the school to pick up an order form from the Parent Resource Room.

Please be advised as a parent/guardian, you have the right to obtain an exemption to this policy. In order to secure an exemption to this policy, you can write a letter requesting the exemption. Then you will be given the Attachment from Chancellor's Regulation A-665 to complete and return to your child's teacher.
