We hope you are doing well and are settling into the routine of being back to school. Families have two options when deciding how their children will learn this year.

**Option 1:** Remote Learning

**Option 2:** Blended Learning

As per the latest Department of Education guidance, families who are currently in Cohort D (fully remote model) have the opportunity to opt into Blended Learning. The Blended learning model is a combination of both in school learning and asynchronous learning at home.

The process outlined below **will be the only opt-in window for families for this 2020-2021 school year.** As such, the process for blended learning opt-in is as follows:

**Blended Learning Opt-In Window for Families**

Monday, November 2nd to Sunday, November 15th

- Families requesting to change from 100% remote to blended learning should complete and submit the [Learning Preference survey](#) during this window.

**Students Begin In-Person Learning**

Weeks of November 30th & December 7th
